- 24 diffuser heads will be cleaned on June 6
- We saved approximately \$2,500 by coordinating diffuser cleaning timing with another nearby project

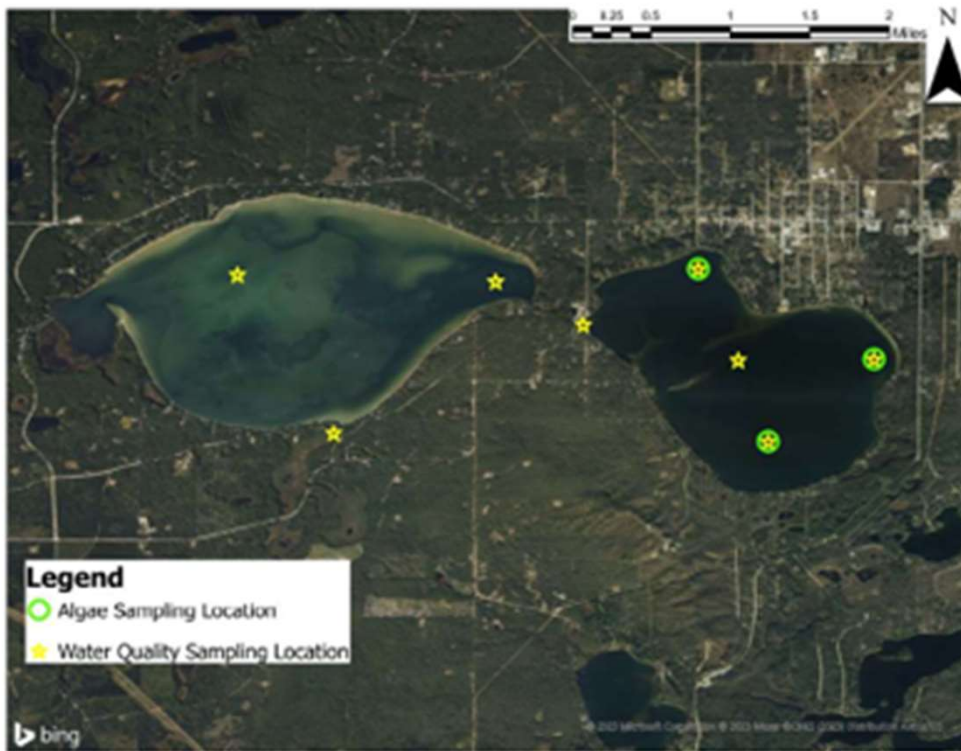
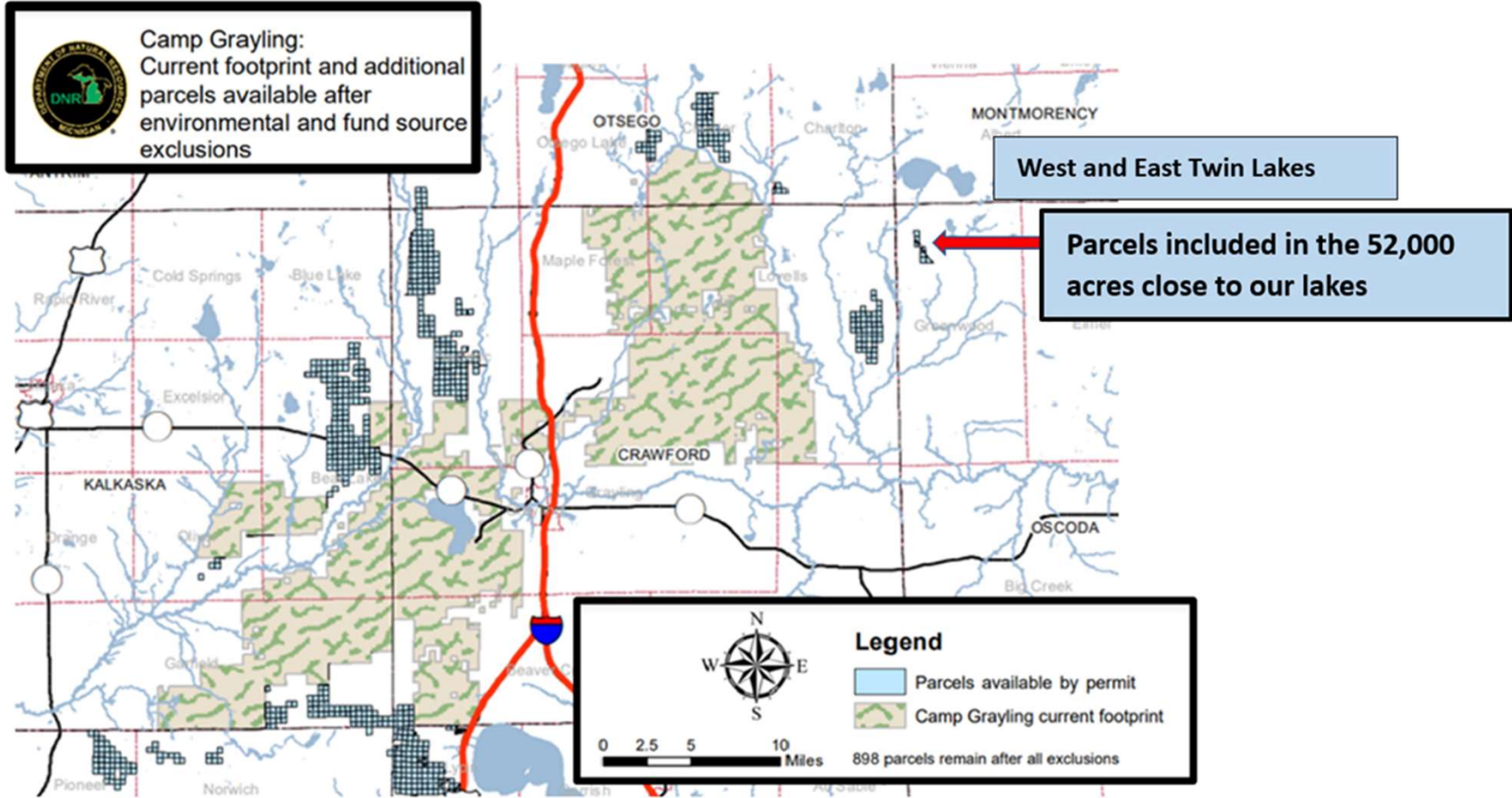


Figure 1: Sample sites located on East and West Twin Lakes.

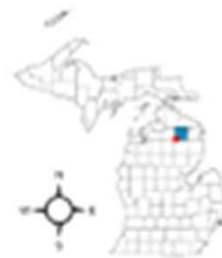

- Implement rain gardens, bioswales, bioretention cells
- Add tree canopy in downtown area to filter pollutants
- Increase street sweeping frequency
